Events include live music, Zumba, a used book sale, children's crafts, Fyr Ball dance, Fyr Bal Regatta, cake walk, trolley rides, historic tours, pet parade, pie and ice cream eating contests, Scandinavian dancers and more – all along the picturesque shoreline of Eagle Harbor. Evening bonfires and fireworks complete the perfect Ephraim day.

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS:

- Completed and signed 2017 Fyr Bal Festival Artisan Market Vendor Application Form.
- Completed Village of Ephraim Transient Merchant Registration Form.
- Completed and signed Wisconsin Temporary Event Operator and Seller Information.
- Enclose a \$100.00 check for each 10' x 10' booth, made payable to **Ephraim Business Council**, which includes the necessary fee for filing each applicant's Transient Merchant Registration Form with the Village of Ephraim. The entire fee is non-refundable upon acceptance into the Artisan Market.

Door County residents are eligible for a 75% discount, and may submit payment of \$25.00. All discounted applications are subject for review.

- Provide a self-addressed stamped envelope for notification and return of submitted materials. Please ensure that the envelope and postage amounts are sufficient. The EBC is not responsible for letters returned for insufficient postage.
- Enclose at least four (4) photographs or a CD of images representative of the pieces you intend to sell. Please label all materials to ensure safe return.

RULES:

1. All exhibited work must be original in concept and executed by the applying artist. Work displayed at the Fyr Bar Art, Craft and Local Products Show must be represented by the photos that accompany the application. No commercial kits, molds, patterns, plans, stencils or pre-fabricated forms will be allowed.
2. Vending space is ten square feet (10'x10'). Please note on this application if you would prefer multiple consecutive booths, and include additional fees.
3. Each vendor is to provide his or her own display and shelters appropriate for outdoor festivals. Staking of tents will not be allowed- Please be prepared to sufficiently weight your tent and all other items.

4. Spaces will be assigned by the Fyr Bal Festival Planning Committee. You will be notified of your location at least one week prior to the event. Set up time is anytime after 4:00pm on Friday, June 16th.
5. Vending hours are 9:00am-8:00pm, and all vendors are required to stay for the full duration of the market.
6. Vendor parking will be provided at the Ephraim Moravian Church, just up the steps at the end of Cherry Street. Vendors are welcome to load and unload along Water Street (Hwy 42), but must relocate all vehicles for permanent parking. Volunteers will monitor vendor parking, and vendors permanently parked outside of the church lot will not be invited to return.
7. Please tear down in a timely and orderly manner, beginning no earlier than 7:00pm. Leave vending area free of trash and other debris.
8. Fyr Bal is a family-oriented event. No weapons are allowed on Village grounds with or without a permit. All vendors are to conduct themselves in a positive, respectful manner, and avoid strong language and profanity. As Ephraim is a dry community, the public sale or consumption of alcohol is prohibited.
9. The Fyr Bal Festival Committee reserves the right to refuse any vendor for any reason.
